November Meeting Highlights

Don Barnes called the meeting to order. The minutes from the October meeting were approved as presented.

Rebecca gave the treasurer's report. The club had a beginning balance of \$5,055.82. The account earned 21 cents interest and \$43 was collected from last month's raffle resulting in an ending balance of \$5,099.03. The treasurer's report was approved.

Don Barnes announced that the board had approved the club offering a \$50 prize for the winner of the wood division at the *It's Elemental* fine crafts exhibition. Bob noted that it would be good to have more wood workers represented in the exhibition and encouraged members to consider submitting something next year. A good photograph is important.

Don Barnes said that he and other members had been exploring an alternate meeting location for January - March while the Bakers are out of town. Local Works on Fourth Street has space with chairs and would welcome the club meeting there. It was believed that there would not be any cost associated with using the space.

There was discussion about what kinds of demonstrations to have during those months. Rebecca suggested starting with a strong demonstration since there might be others in the space interested in watching. Don Barnes suggested that we assess the demonstrations at the Center for the Arts on December 7th and 8th and perhaps get an idea for the January meeting. Rebecca also would be interested in having another "woodeo," if enough additional lathes could be found, perhaps for the February meeting.

The club thanked Jeanette for setting up the display in the public library. Don Baker

was asked to check on the availability of space for next December.

Demonstration and sale times were confirmed as 12 - 4 p.m. for the event at the Coconino Center for the Arts in December. It is believed that we can leave everything there Saturday night so there will be minimal set up on Sunday. Set up on Saturday will begin at 11 a.m. and many hands will be needed to bring in equipment and sale items.

Rebecca asked for feedback from those who participated in the Fall Festival at Warner's Nursery. General agreement was that it was not worth the time and effort. There was more interest in participating in the Warner's craft fair next year.

The December potluck was discussed. Lin will host. Saturday December 14 at 5 p.m. was the date and time selected.

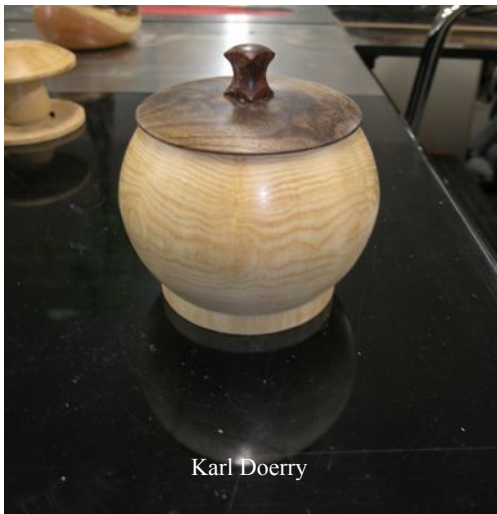

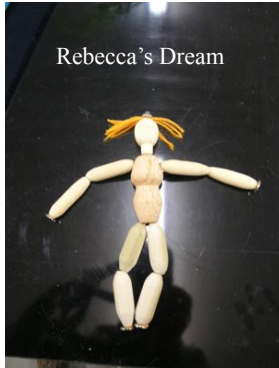

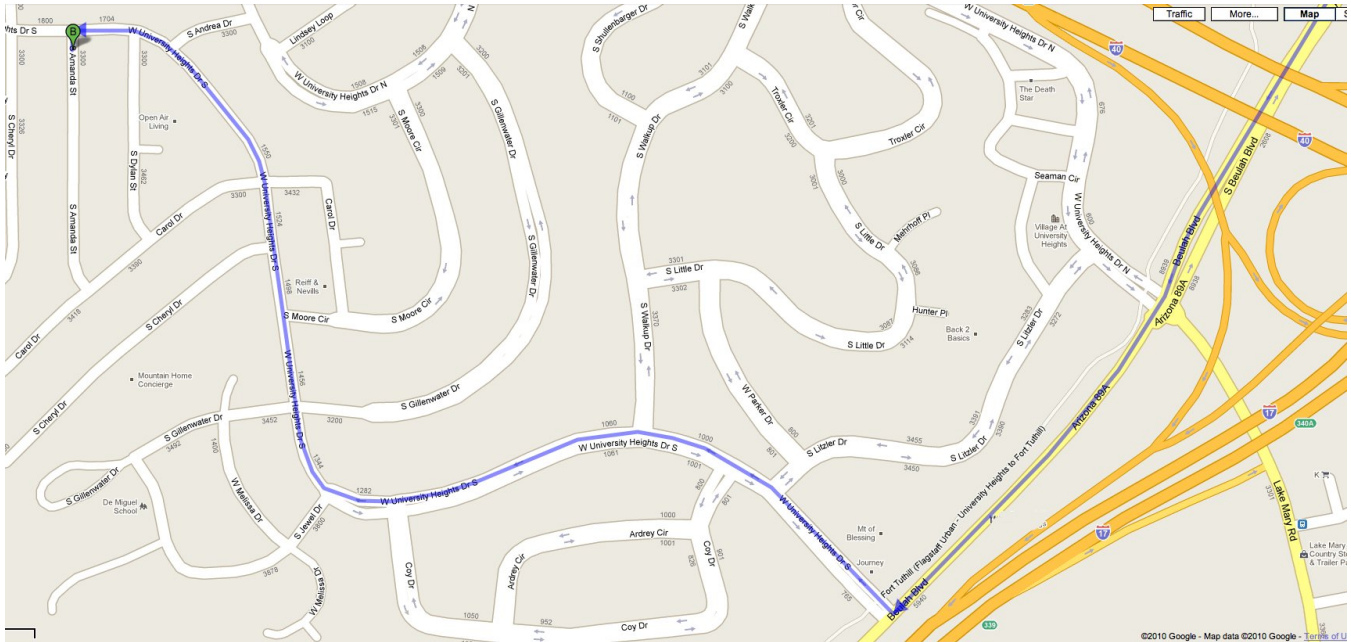
The next meeting will be the holiday potluck hosted by Lin Kwis on December 14 at 5 p.m.. The address is 3502 S. Amanda St.
