Don Barnes called the meeting to order. The minutes from the May meeting were approved as presented.

Rebecca gave the treasurer's report. The beginning balance was \$4,921.51. Income was 21 cents in interest resulting in a current balance of \$4,922.02. The \$49 from last month's raffle will appear in next month's report. The treasurer's report was approved.

Don Barnes noted that Carl Smith had graciously offer to host the summer potluck this year and confirmed with Lin that she was OK to this change in plans since she could still host the December event. Jeanette will provide a map and additional information with the next newsletter.

Jeanette and Don Baker reported that the display at the East Flagstaff Community Library was arranged. There have been no sales, which is not unusual for this location. Thanks to everyone who supplied items for the display.

Rebecca reported that she had been in contact with the County Fair organizers. They will send the form to Jeanette for

completion. Rebecca hasn't confirmed the exact location yet. The club will demonstrate and have items for sale at the Fair on Saturday August 31 and Sunday September 1 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Everyone is expected to participate and there will be a sign-up sheet forthcoming for demonstrating and setting up and tearing down on both days.

Karl Doerry announced that he had seen a notice from the Flagstaff Cultural Partners calling for exhibits at the Coconino Center for the Arts and wondered if that was something the club was interested in. Bob indicated that he had spoken to the group about the club demonstrating and selling for two days in December but hadn't been able to confirm since the schedule is still in the works.

Rebecca asked if the group wanted to have a "white elephant" swap (wood exchange) at the potluck. Don Barnes suggested that anyone interested in participating should bring a piece of wood to exchange.

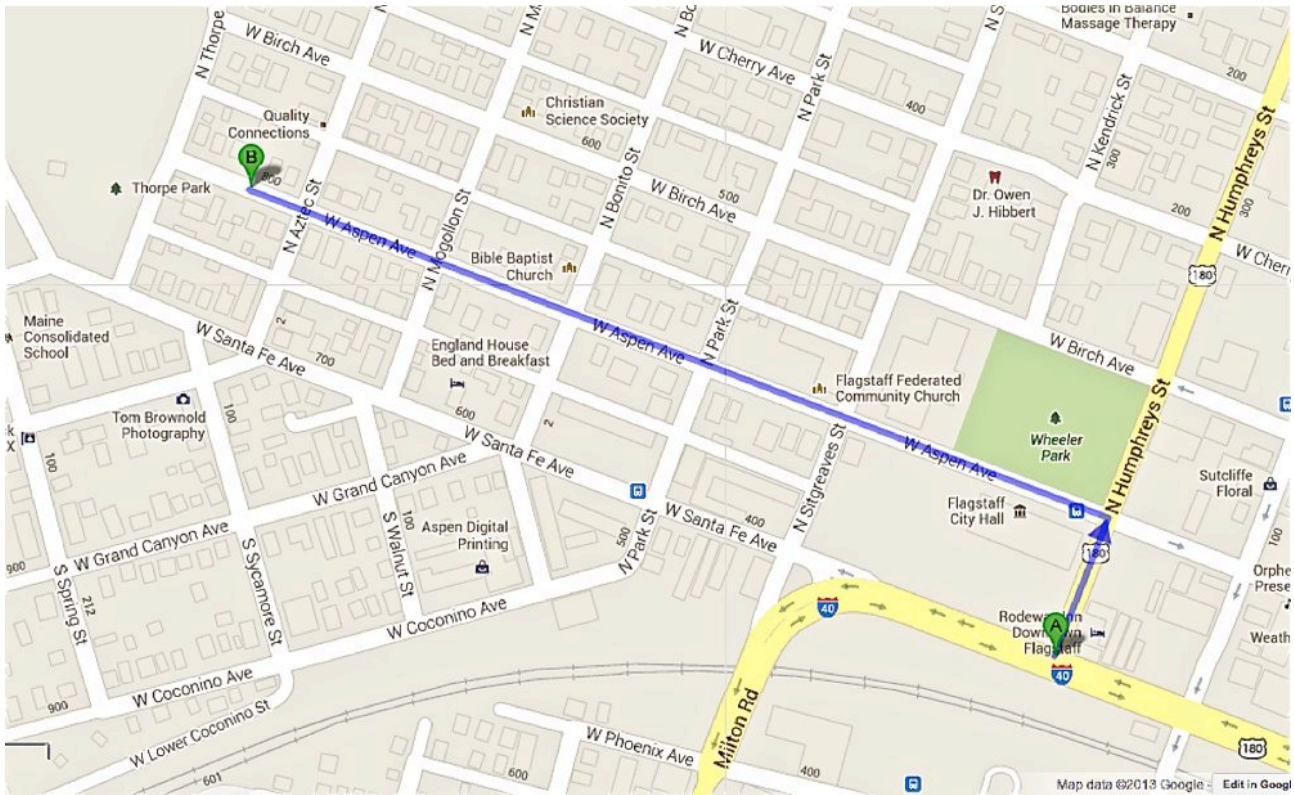
